PASSING OF MRS. E. A. GOODRICH

Mrs. E. A. Goodrich, widow of the late George A. Goodrich, died at her home in Naples last Sunday, April 6. She had been an invalid for twenty-five years.

The funeral was held on Tuesday, conducted by A. A. Haws. The speakers included Joseph H. Gardiner, George A. Davis and E. J. Longhurst. The burial was at the Vernal Cemetery.

Deceased was born in Nauvoo, Illinois January 28, 1844. She was among the first to come across the plains to Utah having arrived here when she was six years old.

During all the years she was a consistant member of the church. She was the mother of eleven children, seven of whom survive her. They are George L. Goodrich, L. H. Goodrich, Byron Goodrich, Mrs. A. T. Collett, Naples; Mrs. Mary Gagon, Mrs. Albert Henry, Roosevelt; Leslie Goodrich, Bluebell.
