FUNERAL HELD FOR FOUR-MONTH OLD THOMAS BABY

MAESER (Special)-- Little Forrest Joseph Thomas, four-month old son of Mr. and Mrs. William Thomas passed away Saturday of pneumonia, following an illness of whooping cough.

Funeral services were held Sunday at 1:15 at the home of George R. Goodrich of Vernal, with Bishop Lester Bigham of Maeser presiding. Mrs. Ethelwynne Collett and Mrs. Leo Smith sweetly sang "Let the Little Ones Come Unto Me," "Jesus Loves Little Children" and "Tell Me Dear Lord." The opening prayer was offered by George A. Slauch and the invocation pronounced by E. J. Longhurst. The speaker was Albert Goodrich who offered words of comfort and consolation.

Interment was made in the Vernal Cemetery with Jerome Goodrich dedicating the grave, which was covered with beautiful, floral tributes. Besides the parents the little one is survived by three brothers and sister.
