

## KENNETH R. GOODRICH OBITUARY

Kenneth R Goodrich, 72, died Tuesday the Dec. 22, 1998 at LDS Hospital from complications after heart surgery.

Kenneth was born April 3, 1926, in Bluebell, Duchesne County, Utah, the son of John and Rosezella Hancock Goodrich. Kenneth married Faye Lisonbee on February 24, 1951, in Elko, Nevada and later solemnized the marriage in the Logan LDS Temple. He attended school in Bluebell and graduated from Altamont High where he was active in their basketball program.

As soon as he graduated he received his "greetings" from Uncle Sam. After basic training he was shipped to Japan and on his way there the bomb was dropped that ended the war. Ken worked as a meat cutter in Provo and American Fork and for 21 years at BYU in the meat department.

He is survived by his wife of Orem; his children, Paul, Le Ann, and Everett of Orem; Brian of Springville, and Craig and Mark, both of Salt Lake City. He is also survived by 17 grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents and four brothers and is survived by three sisters, Carma of Altonah, Ardis of Lander, Wyoming, and Carolyn of Bluebell.

Funeral services will be held Monday, December 28, 1998, at 10 a.m. in the Timpanogos Park 4th Ward chapel, 935 North 300 East in Orem. A viewing will be held Sunday the 27th from 6 to 8 p.m. at the Sundberg-Olpin Mortuary, 495 South State in Orem, and also Monday one hour prior to the services at the ward chapel. Interment will be in the Bluebell City Cemetery.
