

## MARY AUGUSTA GOODRICH GAGNON OBITUARY

Uintah Pioneer, 80, Succumbs. Funeral services for Mary Augusta Gagon, 80, prominent Roosevelt pioneer who died Thursday, July 1, at 5 a.m. of causes incident to age, were conducted Sunday at 2:30 p.m. in the Roosevelt Ward Chapel. Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints. Holis Hullinger, bishop, officiated.

Mrs. Gagon died at the home of a daughter, Mrs. Fannie Todd. She was born January 4, 1868, at Morgan, a daughter of George Albert and Liza Taggart Goodrich. She was married to William H. Gagon in 1890 in the Logan LDS Temple. The family came to Uintah Basin in 1907 where Mr. Gagon died 25 years ago. Mrs. Gagon was an active member in the LDS Church, having served in both the Roosevelt Stake Relief Society and Mutual Improvement Association presidencies.

She is survived by two sons, Rae and Owen Gagon, Salt Lake City; four daughters, Mrs. Mamie Baldwin, Ogden; Mrs. Leona Shumway, Dragerton; Mrs. Fannie Todd and Mrs. Ella Roberts, Roosevelt; two step-sons, Ira Gagon, Roosevelt and Will Gagon, Lancaster, California; three brothers, Lewis and Byron Goodrich, Vernal; and Leslie Goodrich, Bluebell and a sister, Mrs. Nellie Collette, Kaysville.

Burial was in the Roosevelt Cemetery.
