Ricky Goodrich Funeral Rites Held in Naples.

Funeral rites for Ricky C. Goodrich, 16 month-old son of Verdin and LaRae Chivers Goodrich, were held Tuesday at 11 a.m. in the Naples Ward Chapel. He died Saturday in a Salt Lake hospital after a long illness. Bishop Orlo Goodrich conducted the services.

Prayer at the mortuary was given by Charles E. Olsen. Prelude and postlude music was played by Ada Openshaw.

Opening song "My Father Knows" was sung by the Naples Ward choir and Verdin A. Manwaring offered the invocation. A duet, "One Sweetly Solemn Thought," was sung by Orlo and Lowe Goodrich, accompanied by Carolyn Goodrich.

First speaker was President Frank R. Walker and a solo "That Little Boy of Mine" was sung by Tauline Anderson and accompanied by Ada Openshaw.

The choir sang "Softly and Tenderly" for the closing song and benediction was by Carl L. Oldaker.

Burial was in the Vernal Memorial Park Cemetery. Dedication of the grave was by Clarence Palmer, George Coonradt, Howard Horrocks, Glen Reynolds and Clarence Palmer served as pallbearers.

Ricky was born May 13, 1959 in Vernal. Survivors are his parents, brother, sister, Craig, Debra, grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Clyde Chivers, Mr. and Mrs. Delroy Goodrich, great-grandmother, Mrs. May Anderson, all of Vernal.
